

Spectator Guidance for LASA Age Groups and Championships 2025

Please note car parking at Braunstone LC is free

<u>Braunstone</u> - has a limited number of places for spectators. You can pay by cash or card and be given a wristband and we request that you wear it where it is clearly visible to the people on the door.

Only those with the correct colour wristband can occupy the balcony area and we do not want to have to annoy you by keep checking. The reason for this is a) It is a session ticket only and colours will change each session but due to H & S requirements, we have numbers to stick to and we will clear the balcony between sessions. You must take all belongings with you when leaving. Help us to clear by departing a finishing session by or before 10mins after last race of that session.

As it is a Session ticket you will need to queue up again for the new wristband. That will only start when entrance door staff is ready to go. Once our numbers for balcony are met we cannot permit anymore. Ensure YOU DO NOT abuse door staff as it is not their fault there is a limit on seats. Plus all are giving up their time Free of Charge to make this event happen. Your cooperation is sought and expected.

We will allow you to pass wristbands to others but only the complete one, not just a part of it, will be accepted for the next person to use. Scissors will be available at the desk

The people monitoring wristbands/numbers on balcony are <u>all volunteers</u> and we ask that you respect their requests and checks. Abuse is not allowed.

Spectator Area access for this weekend

<u>Braunstone LC</u> As you enter the building, through turn styles area, and continue along foyer to the Spectators desk.

- If you require **(Sportyswim)** they are present during Sunday 2nd February 2025 and Saturday 8th February 2025(Further details will follow) On line sales are open.
- Spectators for viewing balcony, once you have the wristband go up the ramp and although it is an automatic door it might leave help. If seats are marked as reserved ensure you do not use them. We also have a gangway to our AOE staff (where announcer is positioned and they must be left clear.
- All meetings with your swimmer are to be in foyer area not in spectator area
- Please note the number of lockers available should your swimmer need it is a 10p coin refundable. Big bags in Lockers please.



Fire Exits from balcony are at both ends of it. The Fire Exit furthest from where you came in leads out too, but you would be joined by others departing the poolside deck. The other exit is the way you came in. Should the Fire alarm go, an alarm, and this is represented by a full red circle on the light please ready yourselves and await Leisure Centre staff to instruct an exit. If the light is red with a white circle that is the drowning alarm. Should we need to vacate, the Assembly point is the coach parking site furthest point from where you entered the car park.

Please be aware it is can get warm on balcony. However the Leisure Centre does have a café with a good range of food and liquids.

As tickets will be in tight supply we ask the spectators if departing to pass their wrist band to the desk so we can permit someone else to enter the balcony. PLEASE Get your club's parents /guardians to work together on this.
